

Class Information

Creative Movement - Ages 3-4 (45 min)

Children will learn basic ballet skills, as well as, balance coordination, and rhythm. Creativity and imagination are always encouraged. Children will dance with various props to fun children's songs. Children must be completely potty-trained.

Class Time: Mon. 5:30pm - 6:15pm OR
Thurs. 4:15pm - 5:00pm OR
Thurs. 5:00pm - 5:45pm

Tuition: \$360 in full or \$40 per month

Pre-Ballet/Tap - Ages 5-6 (60 min)

Children progress to a more structured dance environment, which includes barre work. Beginning tap steps are introduced. The students will study ballet for approximately 40 minutes and tap for approximately 20 minutes.

Class Time: Mon. 4:30pm - 5:30pm OR
Tues. 4:30pm - 5:30pm OR
Thurs. 5:45pm - 6:45pm

Tuition: \$405 in full or \$45 per month

Elementary Ballet/Tap/Jazz - Ages 7-8 (90 min)

Children become more familiar with ballet terminology and techniques and continue to learn basic tap steps, as new, more advanced techniques are added. Jazz is introduced and centered around stretching and short, fun, routines to popular songs. The students will study ballet for approximately 40 minutes, and jazz and tap for 25 minutes each.

Class Time: Tues. 5:30pm - 7:00pm OR
Wed. 4:00pm - 5:30pm

Tuition: \$495 in full or \$55 per month

Youth Ballet/Tap/Jazz/Hip-Hop - Ages 9-10 (90 min)

Students continue advancing in their techniques and skills. More emphasis is placed on turns and leaps, as we prepare students for future pointe work. Students will learn jazz moves, including Broadway, pop and hip-hop, as well as continuing to learn more advanced tap techniques.

Class Time: Wed. 5:30pm - 7:00pm

Tuition: \$495 in full or \$55 per month

Beginning Pointe - Ages 10-12 (30 min)

This class is by teacher invitation only. You must also be enrolled in a ballet/tap/jazz class. Students will learn basic pointe technique in preparation for more complex skills.

Class Time: Wed. 7:00pm - 7:30pm

Tuition: \$90 in full or \$10 per month

Intermediate I Ballet/Tap/Jazz/Hip-Hop - Ages 11-12 (90 min)

Students are introduced to lyrical dance. Emphasis is placed on developing stage presence. Students will learn jazz moves, including Broadway, pop and hip-hop, as well as continuing to learn more advanced tap techniques.

Class Time: Wed. 7:30pm - 9:00pm

Tuition: \$495 in full or \$55 per month

Intermediate Pointe - Ages 12-14 (30 min)

This class is by teacher invitation only. You must also be enrolled in a ballet/tap/jazz class. Students will refine their pointe technique and begin more complicated exercises.

Class Time: Thurs. 6:45pm - 7:15pm

Tuition: \$90 in full or \$10 per month

Intermediate II Ballet/Tap/Jazz/Hip-Hop - Ages 12-14 (105 min)

Students continue their work in lyrical dance while enhancing their classical ballet technique. Students continue learning jazz moves, including Broadway, pop and hip-hop, as well as focusing on speed and clarity in their tap technique.

Class Time: Thurs. 7:15pm - 9:00pm

Tuition: \$540 in full or \$60 per month

Advanced Pointe - Ages 14-18 (30 min)

This class is by teacher invitation only. You must also be enrolled in a ballet/tap/jazz class. Students work to advance their pointe technique and will learn more challenging skills.

Class Time: Tues. 7:00pm - 7:30pm

Tuition: \$90 in full or \$10 per month

Advanced Ballet/Tap/Jazz/Hip-Hop - Ages 14-18 (105 min)

Emphasis is placed on lyrical and contemporary dance and the expression of emotion through movement, while still practicing traditional ballet techniques. Students continue learning Broadway, pop, and hip-hop moves, as well as, challenging tap combinations.

Class Time: Tues. 7:30pm - 9:15pm

Tuition: \$540 in full or \$60 per month

Adult Ballet/Tap/Jazz - Ages 19 and up (90 min)

Come get some exercise and refresh your old dance skills. This is a fun, intermediate level adult class. This class will only meet three weeks a month. We will provide you with a schedule.

Class Time: Mon. 7:30pm - 9:00pm

Tuition: \$405 in full or \$45 per month

PRIVATE LESSONS - Private Lessons may be requested by dancers ages 6 and up at a rate of \$20 per half hour or \$35 per hour. You can brush up on a few steps or work on your recital routine. If you are getting ready for a pageant or show, we can help. You can schedule one lesson or many. You pay as you go, so it's up to you.

Hair **MUST** be secured away from the face in a bun or ponytail. Only stud earrings are allowed. No other jewelry is allowed.

If a class does not reach its required minimum by Aug. 10th, you will be notified and given the opportunity to choose another class time or given a refund. You will be notified immediately if a class is full.

CLASS TIMES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE.

Ages are given as a guideline, however final class placement is at the instructor's discretion.

Tuition

Tuition may be paid in full or monthly. The monthly rate is a constant, prorated fee and does not change due to absences, inclement weather cancellations, or number of classes per month. If paying monthly, the first month's tuition is due during the summer. Your next tuition payment will be due at the first class in October and all subsequent monthly payments are due at the first class of each month. Monthly payments must be remitted BEFORE the second class of the month or a \$20 late fee will be charged. There are no exceptions. There is a \$25 returned check fee. No refunds are allowed. Listed tuition prices do not include costume payments. Payments can be made by cash or check - no credit cards can be accepted.

Family Discount

If more than one member of your immediate family is enrolled in classes, reduce the additional payment by \$10 a month.

Ex. 2 students = \$10/month discount

3 students = \$20/month discount

Referral Discount (available to current/former students only)

You can receive a \$10 credit towards tuition for each new enrolled student you referred. Each new student can only be referred by one person and they must write that person's name on their registration form. There is no limit on the number of referrals you can have. A credit will be issued in November and can be used toward tuition at any point thereafter.

Costume Fees

Your child will require one recital costume for each type of dance he or she takes. For example, a student who takes Pre-ballet/Tap will need 2 costumes. An initial costume deposit of \$60 will be due the first week of November for all students. If your child is in 2 or more dances, a second deposit of \$60 will be due the first week of December. If your child is in 3 or more dances, a third deposit of \$60 will be due the first week back in January. Any further costume payments needed will be broken down after the first of the year.
